

Deckhand Continuous

Overview

The Deckhand Continuous performs deck duties to support the operation and maintenance of marine vessels and sails as a Small Vessel Machinery Operator. The role works with LNG tankers, docking and undocking during one shift and as such is physically demanding. This includes handling deck lines, wires, and towing tackle for both the tug and tankers.

Duties and Accountabilities

- Handles deck lines, wires, and towing tackle for both the tug and tow. Ensures the berthing of tugs using cables.
- Maintains cleanliness of the deck. Performs cleaning, cutting, polishing and painting work in relation to tug maintenance.
- Adjusts the bridge and see to the safe transfer of persons.
- Works in the engine room and chips and paints marine vessels as required.
- Complies with all company policies and SOPs and ensures that all officers and crew understand and follow all policies, procedures, orders and instructions.
- Sails as a Small Vessel Machinery Operator (SVMO) as applicable.
- Identifies, assesses and reports all risks and hazards to the supervisor.
- Reports all injuries to the supervisor.
- Performs additional duties as assigned.

Qualification Requirements

- Certifications required – Bridge Watch Rating, Marine Basic First Aid, Small Vessel Machinery Operator, Radio Operator Certificate, FoodSafe Level 1, Basic Safety Training, and a Transport Canada Marine Medical Certificate.
- No previous experience required.

Skills, Knowledge and Required Competencies

- Understanding of the deckhand responsibilities under the CLC Part II and MOHS Regulations.
- Understanding of the company Health, Safety, Wellness, Environmental and Quality Policies.
- Ability to communicate effectively and seek answers, when unclear about duties and responsibilities.
- Knowledge of all emergency equipment and emergency duties.
- Understanding of all hazards associated with day-to-day activities.
- Ability to take direction and properly use all safety and firefighting equipment on the tug.
- Ability to work in difficult climatic conditions.
